It's District Safety Meeting time! Check the schedule on the back of this form for the location near you.

“Pressure Limitations for Propane Systems” one of the most asked questions is, “How much gas pressure is acceptable in a building?”

When a leak occurs in a 5 psi gas piping system, the flow of gas is proportional to the pressure. Most gas appliances are designed for and operate substantially below 5 psi. Leakage in a piping system that operates at 11 in. w.c. would be significantly less than a system operating at 5 psi. Join us for our spring district meetings as we will look at the pressure limitations on a propane system and why they are in place. During the meeting we will discuss the exceptions to the 5 psi limitation.

The 2019 Spring District Safety Meetings kick off on March 18 in Cameron at the Cameron Community Building, and continue throughout the state at familiar locations, ending March 28 in Eugene. In addition to the program items listed above, you will visit with your peers, enjoy a group meal and have a chance to win door prizes. Everyone from your location is invited.
