CETP Module 4.1: Vapor Distribution. What to expect: Students will take a number of guizzes and tests in order to assess their pace of learning. A multiple choice test will be administered at the end of the class. Topics covered in this class but not limited to: Preparing tanks and cylinders for transporting; locating underground utilities and services; preparing foundations; installing regulators; sizing distribution lines, copper tubing, steel piping and corrugated stainless steel tubing; performing pressure tests on gas distribution lines; performing leak checks, flow checks; operating pressure requirements; placing appliances into service; documenting and recordkeeping; communicating safety information to customers. Tests are graded by a third party and the results are mailed to each company.

MO-PERC (Missouri Propane Education & Research Council) funding underwrites the cost of student and test materials as well as a copy of 2020 NFPA 58, pencils, markers and other materials. Lunch and break refreshments are also provided. Other meals, lodging and travel are not included in the class fee.
